**June 15th 11:00 to 4:30**

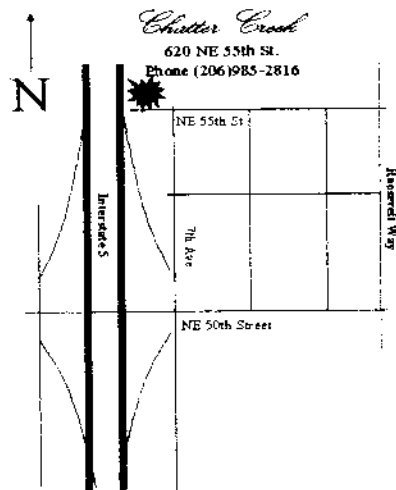
check out the 2001 vintage

Spring is when the new red wines really begin to show the full potential of the vintage. This is the time of year when as a winemaker I can begin to plan the assemblage of the up coming wines.

I've begun to work at blending the 2001's and am very excited about what I'm seeing in the barrels. This upcoming fall bottling of Syrah and Cabernet Franc look like they will surpass quality of the 2000 vintage releases. The 2000 Cabernet Sauvignon is about ready to bottle and is a wine that is so balanced that it's hard to pick apart the components that produced it. The 2001 Cabernet Sauvignon is awake after it's winter slumber and is about ready for blending.

June 15 will be a rare opportunity for you to see all the components of all the wines, in barrel before they are blended, and a chance to try your hand at the art of blending yourself. Have you ever wanted to see how blends are assembled? What process does a winemaker go through when thinking of and planning out the next great wine? Have you ever been tempted to pour two wines together just to see what might happen?

**This is your chance to come play!**



**From the north.** Take I-5 to the NE 50th St. exit, turn left on to 50th St., go across the freeway, turn left on to 7th Ave and go to 55th St. turn left and park.

**From the south and SR520.** Take I-5 to the NE 50th St exit. This will put you on 7th Ave. Stay on 7th Ave across 50th to 55th St. Turn left and park.
