Find out why Memphis, Tennessee's *The Commercial Appeal* reported that "it gushes with an enchanting bouquet it is immense, without relying on over-powering oak and tannin, and its combination of vibrancy and grip are irresistible." Less than sixty cases of this wine exist at the winery, so order yours today!
- Taste our cranberry lamb haggis, a Scottish speciality; you'll want the recipe to make your very own! When spread atop locally made scones, our gourmet haggis is perfect when accompanied by Glen Fiona Syrah.
