SPRING NEWS

We have been busy in the cellar over the last couple of months completing the first racking of our 2003 wines. During the course of fermentation, there is a settling of minute dead yeast cells, microscopic particles of grape skins, and pulp to the bottom of the barrel. Racking is done to help achieve clarity in the wine by siphoning the clear wine from one barrel to another and discarding the insoluble matter. We also completed the final racking of our 2002 wines in early January in preparation for bottling in February.

Spring has arrived in the Walla Walla Valley and with it the first real assessment of winter damage to the vineyards. There is no question that the winter cold snap was hard on some of Washington's grape plants and, as a result, we may have to modify our plans a bit in order to obtain fruit that will produce the quality of wines that we strive to make. We have started discussions with our vineyard sources and feel confident that we will be able to obtain fruit that will result in another good vintage for Saviah.

Our 2002 wines were bottled on February 11th and have been quietly resting in the cellar in preparation for their April introduction. We will release three wines on April 30th including the acclaimed Une Vallée Red and a Columbia Valley Syrah. We are also excited to introduce our first white wine—an exceptional Bordeaux-style white blend that is simply delicious. This wine is generating lots of interest and with only 92 cases produced, it won't last long.

We will release an additional three wines this Fall including our Stillwater Creek vineyard-designate Chardonnay, Red Mountain Syrah and the debut of our Columbia Valley Big Sky Cuvée. Watch for more information on these wines in a future newsletter.

As you can see by our Upcoming Events list, we will be quite busy between now and mid-summer with numerous wine events. Please stop by to say hello and try the new wines if you are in the area.

Our tasting room will re-open on April 30th and will be open on Saturdays from 11 am to 5 pm through October. If Saturday is not convenient for you, just give us a call and we'll make arrangements to meet you at the winery at another time.

NEW RELEASES

2002 Walla Walla Valley Une Vallée Red Wine

63% Cabernet Sauvignon • 25% Merlot • 12% Cabernet Franc

Une Vallée, or *One Valley*, is our proprietary red wine produced with fruit from Seven Hills Vineyard and Pepper Bridge Vineyard, two of Washington's finest. Our 2002 vintage is smooth and concentrated, with layers of black fruit, silky tannins and an intense floral nose. The ripe fruit from the cabernet franc adds just the right amount of spice and subtle dried herb aromas. 325 cases produced.

2002 Columbia Valley Syrah

This Syrah is produced from vineyards in two appellations which complement each other like two people who have just fallen in love. Stillwater Creek Vineyard in the Columbia Valley is the masculine component and provides acidity and ample tannins. The fruit from Pepper Bridge Vineyard in the Walla Walla Valley is sexy, soft and supple and adds gorgeous color and aromas. This is a deep-colored, well-balanced, and complex wine from start to finish. It features flavors of wild berries, violets, and spice with subtle hints of smoked meats and earthy nuances. 178 cases produced.

2003 Red Mountain Star Meadows White Wine

53% Semillon • 47% Sauvignon Blanc

The grapes for this classic Bordeaux-style blend of Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc were selected from Klipsun Vineyard in Washington State's Red Mountain appellation. The juice was slowly fermented and then sur lie aged in french oak for increased richness on the palate. This delicious wine is packed with rich flavors of ripe fruit that are handsomely underscored with spicy french oak. 92 cases produced.

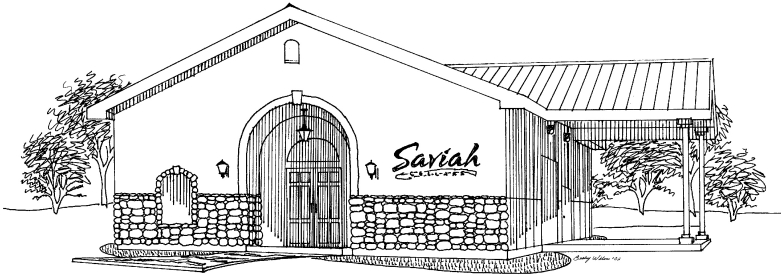
