Thank you to everyone who visited us during the December 2002 barrel tasting. It was our first public event at the new winery and it turned out to be a wonderful and memorable weekend. Also, many thanks to those of you who placed pre-release orders for our 2001 wines.

Our 2001 vintage was bottled in early February and we can hardly wait for its release in May 2003. This second release is exceptional, with more character, depth and balance than our first release. We have added a Merlot to our selection this year, with fruit from two outstanding Walla Walla Valley vineyards. These 2001 wines were incredibly popular at barrel tasting and, although we increased our production over the prior year, supplies are limited, so we encourage you to order early.

We have began work in our estate vineyard and are working on the plans for a second vineyard to be planted this spring. These projects require a big effort, but will enhance our overall fruit portfolio. Our ability to source fruit from Eastern Washington's finest vineyards combined with our small production, allows our winemaker to nurture and craft wines of remarkable quality and style.

Our tasting room will re-open in May and will be open on Saturdays from 11 am to 5 pm through October. Or, call us and make arrangements to come by at another time.

SPRING 2003 RELEASES 2001 Red Mountain Syrah

Red Mountain grapes from Kiona Vineyard produced another outstanding Syrah. A delicious full-bodied wine with gorgeous, blackberry aromas. Blueberry, dark chocolate flavors and exotic spice tease your palate. If you are a syrah fan, you will enjoy this big, classic syrah.

2001 Une Vallée Walla Walla Valley Red Wine

63% Cabernet Sauvignon ● 25% Merlot ● 12% Cabernet Franc

Une Vallée, or *One Valley*, is our proprietary red wine produced with fruit from Seven Hills Vineyard and Pepper Bridge Vineyard, two of Washington's finest. This wine is bursting with a big black cherry nose, with hints of pencil shavings and moist loam. The sweet oak and soft tannins are nicely integrated. An elegant, complex wine that is enjoyable now and will age beautifully.

2001 Walla Walla Valley Merlot

The deep red color of this beautiful merlot gives way to sweet berry fruit aromas and a touch of mocha. The fruit from Seven Hills Vineyard lends a silky character and combines beautifully with the spicy, dark fruit from Spring Valley Vineyard for a well-balanced mouth-filling quality. Penetrating cherry and plum flavors linger with freshly roasted coffee on the finish.


