



# New and Current Releases



Seven Hills is offering an outstanding selection of new and current releases for the Holiday Season. The portfolio is dominated by 1998 red wines—a very warm, ripe vintage.

Our 1999 whites, fromperhaps our favorite white wine vintage of the decade, are also available.

### New Releases

#### 1998 Klipsun Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Deeply colored, powerfully structured, eminently ageable. An earthiness in the nose surrounded by black fruit aromas. Length, mouth filling and sustained flavours. A collectible Northwest Cabernet from a vineyard we've worked with for a decade. \$28

#### 1998 Seven Hills Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Elegance, complexity and breadth that exhibits the essential *terroir* of Seven Hills Vineyard. A wine of medium body packed with abundant flavours: Cassis, red cherry, raspberry and herb. A Cabernet styled to truly complement a fine meal. \$28

#### 1998 Klipsun Vineyard Merlot

Limited production and a reputation for being among the lushest Merlots in Washington make this a highly sought-after release. Ripe berry and cherry flavours are accented with spice and vanilla from Russian, French and American oaks. \$30

# Gift packaging

We are prepared for the holidays with wine gift packaging and shipping boxes—both decorative cardboard and branded wooden boxes in two or three bottle sizes. Wines requiring shipment can be tissue wrapped before being placed in protective shipping boxes. We can help with gifts for wine lovers on your list whether they be family, friends or business associates.

#### 1998 Reserve Seven Hills Vineyard Merlot

A dense, complex Merlot selected exclusively from the oldest block of vines from Seven Hills Vineyard. Warm, deep flavours that only the older vines can give. A very special wine, and our first ever Reserve designation for Merlot. \$32

Also available are the 1998 <u>Columbia</u> Valley Merlot (\$20) and Cabernet Sauvignon (\$22).

These are blended from sites around the appellation, but tend to have a heavy Walla Walla Valley component. Styled to be more accessible than the vineyard-designated wines, but cellared under the same exacting standards. A very few 1996 Seven Hills Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon magnums are available from the library. They come in their own wooden, imprinted box, and are a great gift for a wine lover (\$75). The 1996 vintage will be drinking well for years.

The Barrique Society

Barrique Society members received their first delivery from Seven Hills in early November, a delicious pair of 1998 Cabernet Sauvignons. We're enjoying your comments on the wines and the beautiful black and white images of crush, photographed by Hans Matschukat, posted on the Barrique Society page on our website.

The Barrique Society is Seven Hills' wine club, so named for the style of barrels we use to age our red wines. Members receive three shipments of wine each year. A two bottle shipment in March of our most limited red wines, a three bottle shipment in May including a Pinot Gris and one each of our vineyard designated Merlots, and a two bottle shipment in November containing a Seven Hills Vineyard and Klipsun Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon. Memberships received before January 31, 2001, may choose to start with the Cabernet Sauvignon shipment or the scheduled March delivery. Benefits of membership include discounts on wine and pre-release access to limited bottlings.
