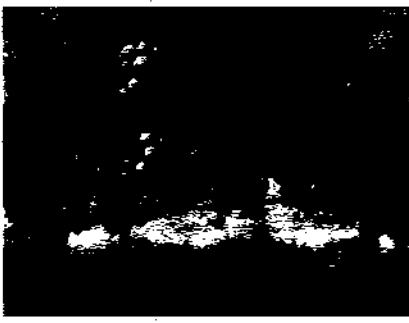


Harvest 2001



Here we go. We brought in our first dolcetto grapes yesterday and the flavors are absolutely fantastic! Merlot is getting close as well. I have been so busy this last month with marketing, vineyard work and vacation

that I nearly forgot about our September letter. This one is going to be brief and to the point.

I am expecting great things from 2001! Most vineyards appear to be less vigorous this year and in more overall balance with canopy and fruit load. I am seeing signs of earlier physiological maturity in the grapes too. This should extrapolate into ripe fruit, but with lower alcohols. We will see . . .

NEW WINES FOR RELEASE ARE:

1999 "Artist Series" cabernet sauvignon

79% cabernet sauvignon

17% merlot

4% cabernet franc

This wine is integrated with spicy new oak, generous black fruits, a silky texture and deep purple color. The wine is beautifully proportioned with a long finish of cassis, chocolate covered cherries, mocha and vanilla. 1999 is a spectacular red wine vintage for Washington! Do not miss this wine!

\$42.50 per bottle through October.

2000 Columbia Valley chardonnay

This is a delightful follow up to our very nice 1999 chardonnay. The 2000 is showing perhaps a bit more restraint, but is still beautifully balanced. Beautiful flavors of ripe pear, peach and nectarine show in this wine, accompanied by the acidity of Granny Smith apples.

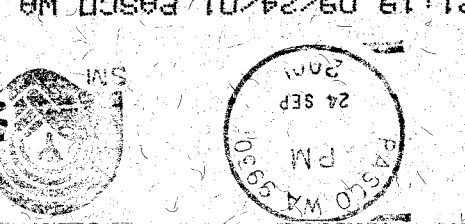
